## Combined Requirements for the Transferable Associate Degree and the CSU General Education Pattern

<p>Requirements for the CSU GE AA degree (minimum 2.0 GPA required):</p> <p><b>1. 60 CSU transferable units.</b> Use of units from other community colleges must be checked on ASSIST at <a href="http://www.assist.org">www.assist.org</a>. A Cabrillo College counselor must check use of units from out-of-state or 4-year universities. You must provide official transcripts from all schools attended.</p> <p><b>2. General Education:</b> Complete at least 30 units of general education including all of Area A and Area B4, which must be completed with a "C -" or better. Students who complete only 30 units will have at least 9 units of lower-division GE courses to complete upon transfer. It is advisable to complete all 39 units of lower division general education before transfer and to have your GE fully certified. Full GE certification is required for the AA-T/AS-T degrees. Courses may be used to satisfy both major and general education requirements. The units will be counted only once for the degree. Courses listed in more than one GE area can fulfill only one GE area.</p> <p><b>3. Multicultural Studies course:</b> Complete one multicultural course marked with a # (not required for the AA-T/AS-T degrees).</p> <p><b>4. Major:</b> For Students beginning Fall 2010, all courses in the major or emphasis must be completed with a "C" or better. AA degrees in a specific discipline require a minimum of 18 units in the major. AS degrees in a specific discipline require a minimum of 30 units in the major.</p> <p>To file a petition for this degree, make an appointment with a counselor during the semester in which you are completing all of the requirements.</p>
