CSU TRANSFER INFORMATION

"Golden Four" Requirement

Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 are considered the "Golden Four" and must be completed with grades of "C" or higher. Note: high unit programs (e.g., Engineering) may not require Area A3 Critical Thinking prior to transfer.

Junior Status (Upper Division Transfer)

A student is required to earn 60 CSU transferable units with a minimum 2.0 GPA, including general education courses, major requirements, and/or general electives. A maximum of 70 lower division units may be transferred.

Many CSU campuses will NOT allow students to complete minimum coursework required for admission in the Summer term prior to Fall admissions, nor in the Fall prior to Spring admission. Please see a counselor at College of Marin for specific campus deadlines.

Lower Division Transfer

Select CSU campuses accept lower division transfer students. Please see a counselor to determine if your campus of interest accepts lower division transfer students in your major.

Foreign Language

While it is not required for GE certification, some campuses require a foreign language for graduation. Certain programs may have a foreign language requirement. See a counselor for details.

GENERAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATION

General Information

Certification refers to an official notification from a community college that a transfer student has completed the lower division General Education requirements for the CSU bachelor's degree program. Students will complete upper division general education at the CSU.

Please request the certification at the last community college you attend prior to transfer. COM transfer students should request CSU GE Certification during your final semester at College of Marin.

Students can also apply for a **Certificate of Achievement: CSU GE Breadth.** See a counselor for details and application.

Full Certification is given to students who have completed all areas of the CSU General Education Pattern outlined on the reverse side of this document.

Subject Area (partial) Certification can be granted for one or more completed areas (A-F) if all areas of the CSU General Education have not been completed.

US History, Constitution and American Ideals

All CSU campuses require a U.S. History and an American Government course for graduation. This requirement may be met prior to transfer but does not impact certification of general education.
