TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR TRANSFER AS A JUNIOR TO A CSU CAMPUS, YOU MUST:

- Complete at least 60 CSU transferable units with a "C" average (2.0)
• Complete at least 30 of the 39 units from the GE courses listed below, including one course from each of the following areas: A1, A2, A3, and B4 with grades of "C-" or higher. Please be aware that for some campuses and majors, you may not complete Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 during your last term prior to enrolling at a CSU campus. Please see counselor for specifics.
