  - You will not receive "extra points" for a creative or well designed video. Try your best.

### Video Prompt:

- Your video can take any creative liberty, you **must answer the following questions in 5 minutes maximum.** 
  - Introduce yourself (name, major, current academic status, ect).
  - What did you learn from your previous year(s) as an RA? How would that experience help you as a returning RA?
  - What is your definition of a mentor, and how would you mentor new RAs?
  - What community/area would you like to be an RA for (freshmen, transfers, second years, upperclassmen, international students)
  - Why would your strengths best suit you in the community you prefer?
    - Note, This is an interesting inquiry and does NOT guarantee placement.
- If you do not answer the questions above, your video may be considered incomplete.
