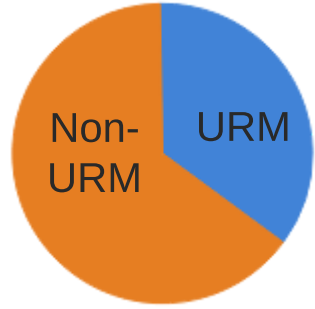

AVERAGE TIME TO DEGREE

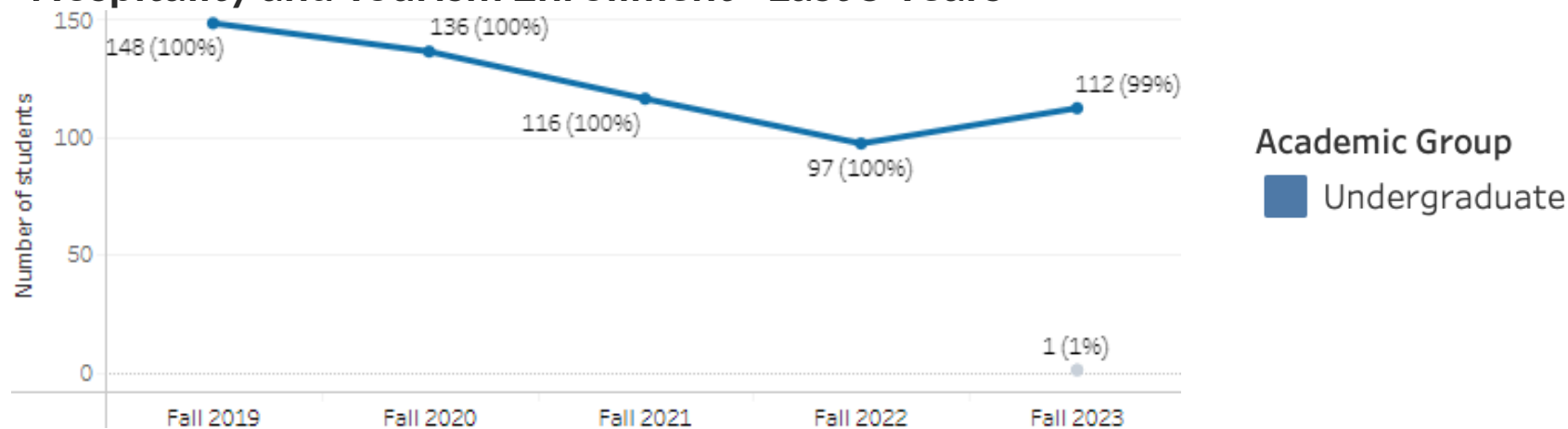
