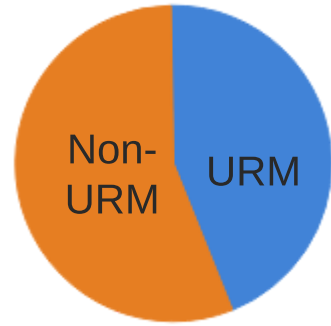


Recreation Program Insights

AVERAGE TIME TO DEGREE

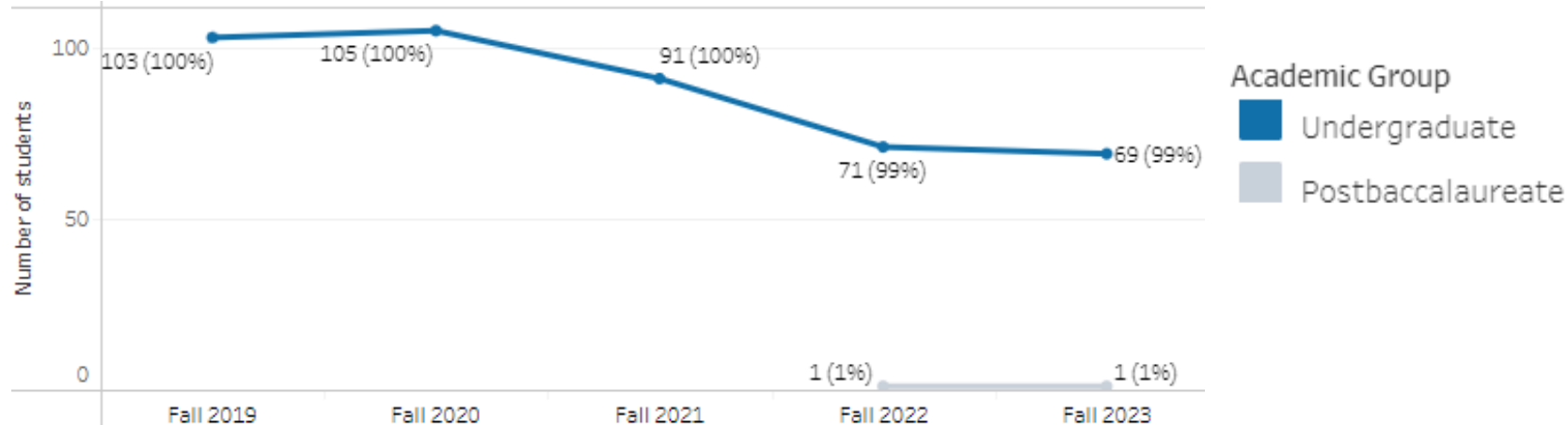
