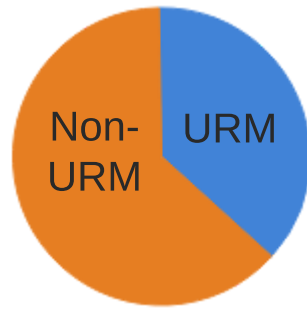




UG MAJORS

AVERAGE TIME TO DEGREE

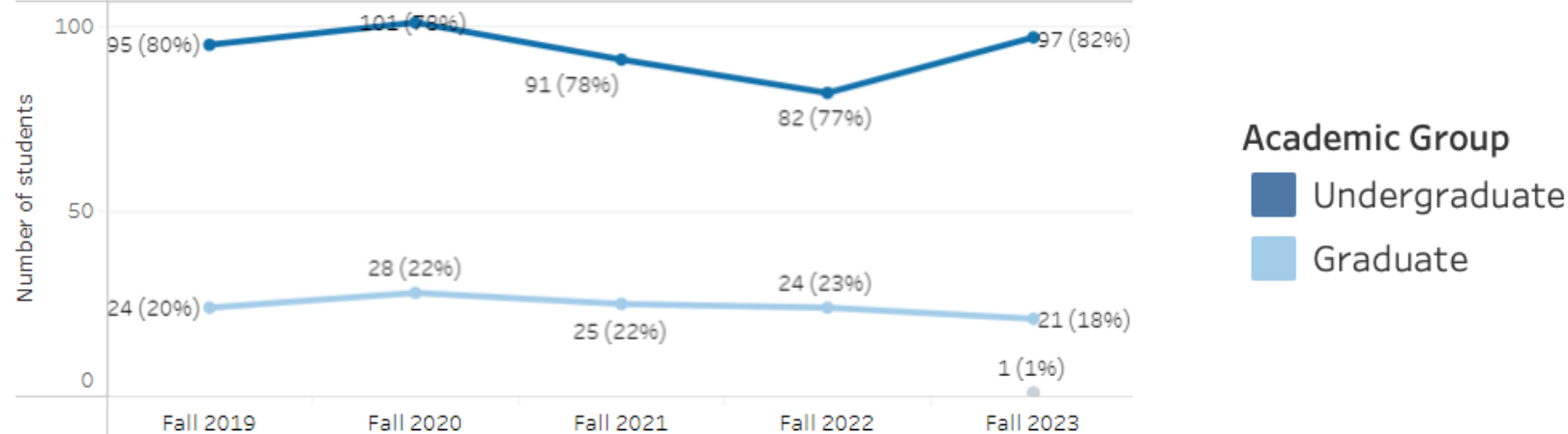
