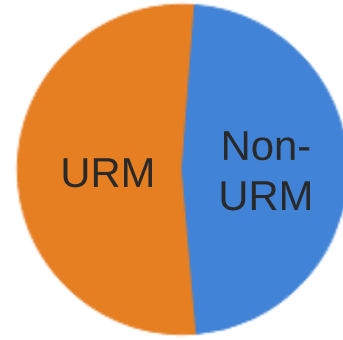

URM Transfer (T): 2.7 Years

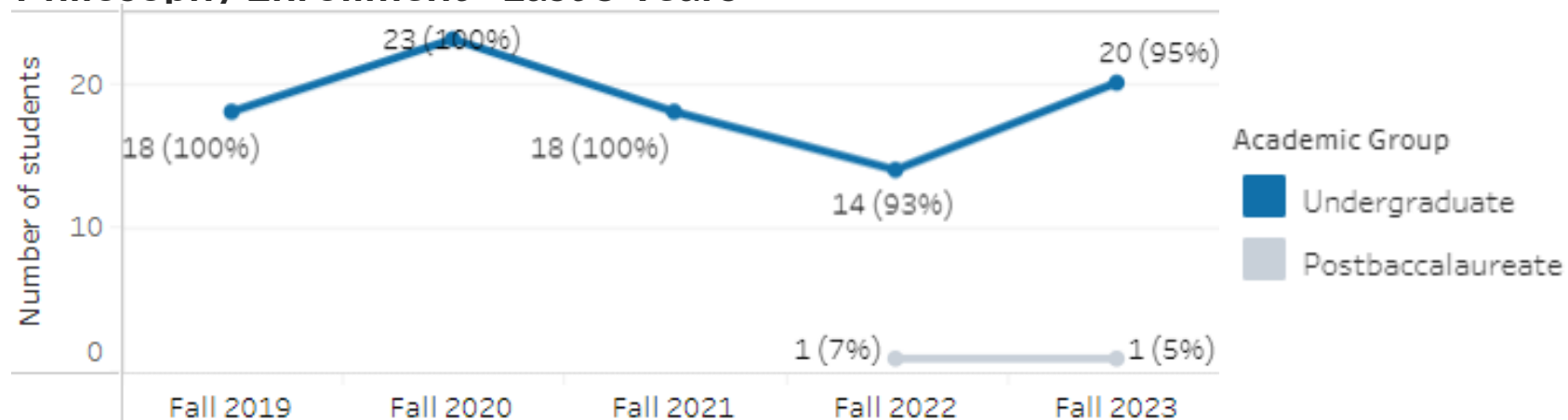
