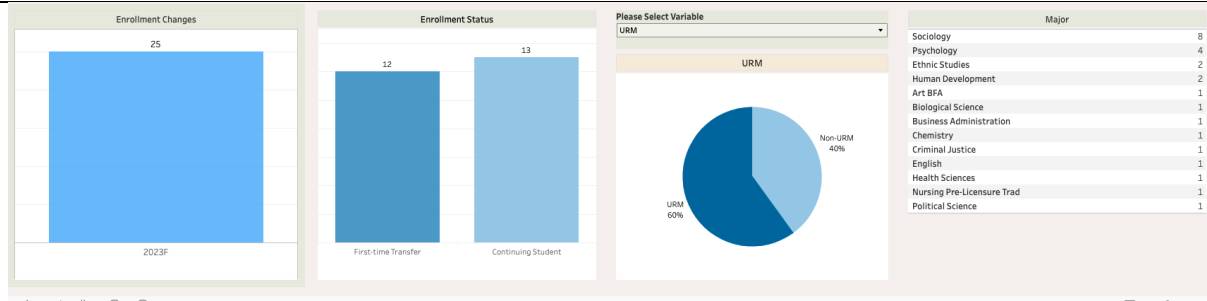


Fig. 1. Project Rebound Population (2023 is the first year so no retention or graduation data available yet)

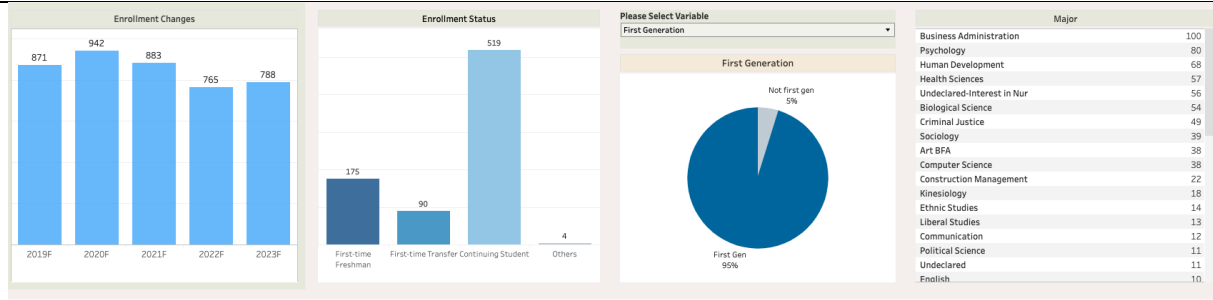


Fig. 2. EOP Population

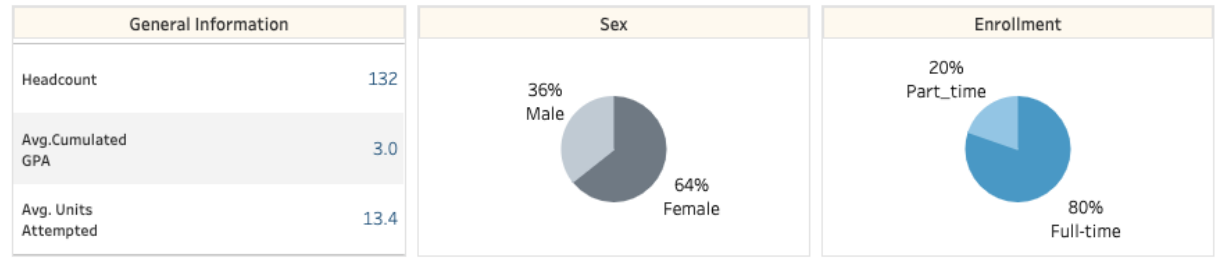


Fig. 3. AB540 Population

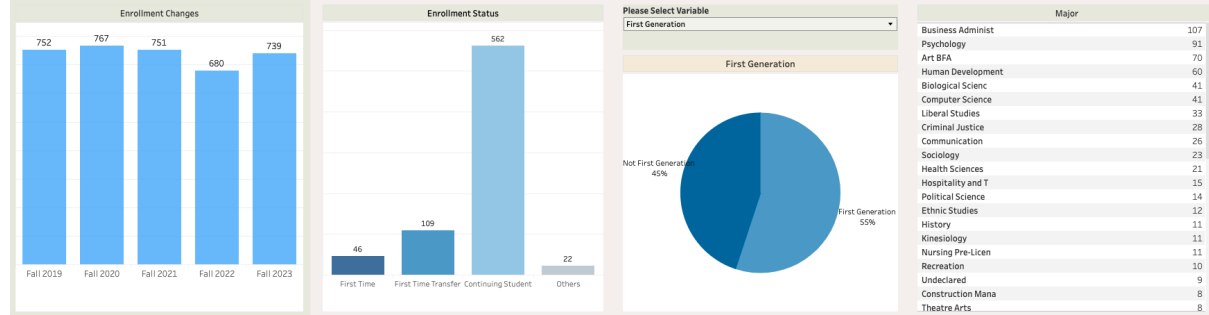


Fig 4. Accessibility Services Population

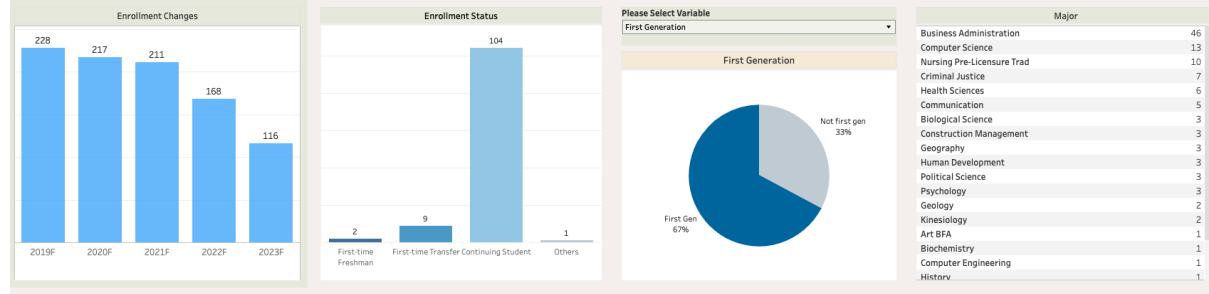


Fig. 5. Veteran's Services Population

Appendix 1: Accurate and actionable communications

The Office of Admissions continues to improve communications to applicants through various formats. The Admissions website was revamped to highlight pertinent information for each stage of each application process, serving as a one-stop shop for the information students need before they think of what to ask. Surveys show that websites are still one of the leading methods for students to get information. Emails from the Admissions Office are tailored to target the various student populations and include specific information students need without having them log in to the student portal. In addition, the official MyCSUEB portal is reviewed and maintained regularly to only display accurate and current information, leading students to complete their applications and receive admission decisions sooner. The new Future Pioneer student portal leverages the latest in technology while delivering dynamic content and helpful information about next steps at CSUEB. Accurate and actionable communication is the foundation of the success of the Admissions Office and is heavily utilized during every step of the admission process.

Significant improvements in communication not only include engaging graphics and student-friendly language, but also descriptive text informing students exactly what they still need to submit in order to complete their admission files.

Note the difference between the screenshots in Fig. 6 and Fig. 7.

Fig. 6 contains the message “Be sure to check MyCSUEB for a current listing of transcripts and required documents still needed to complete your file” while the improved communication template in Fig. 7 specifically targets missing transcripts and listing them, eliminating the need for applicants to log in to retrieve that information.

Appendix 2: The Reimagining of the Student Portal

Launched in 2013, the CSUEB portal ("MyCSUEB") served its purpose, but its outdated interface was no longer user-friendly. A glaring pain point: applicants had to click each transcript entry on a static "To Do List" to understand which document was still needed, a tedious and confusing process.

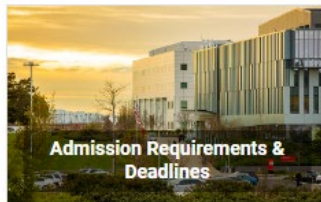
Fig. 9. Future Pioneer Portal for Applied Applicant

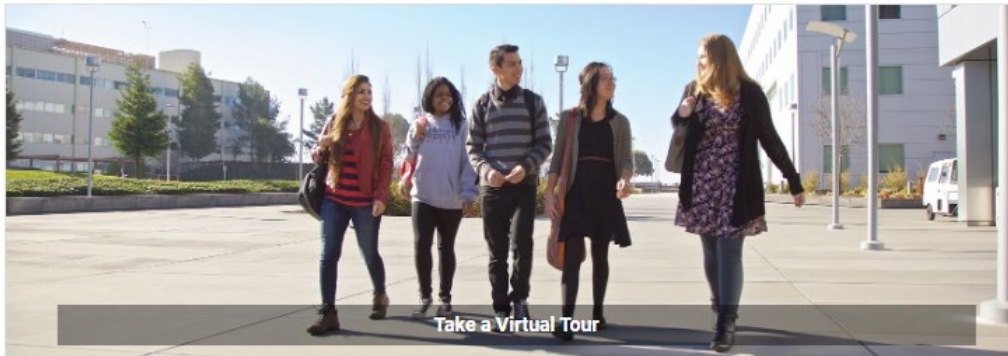


Fig. 10. Future Pioneer Portal for an Admitted Applicant

Introducing the Future Pioneer Portal: Enter the Future Pioneer Portal, designed with both applicants and Admissions staff in mind. This new portal delivers a **personalized and visually appealing experience**, guiding applicants through each step of the admission process with **clear, actionable information and timely suggestions** (see Fig. 9, Fig. 10, Fig 11).

Here are some of the improvements:

- Students are greeted with personalized content such as preferred name, NetID, major and other pertinent information
- Pictures and videos
- Student and alum voices in the form of testimonial videos
- Completed items are listed under “Completed to Do’s” and items that still need attention are listed under “In Progress To Do’s”.
- Transcript names are spelled out without students having to click through multiple times.
- Important reminders appear on every page, letting applicants know of what they should be doing at that stage of the application: activate their NetID and email, apply for financial aid, apply for housing, sign up for a physical or virtual tour, advisor information etc...

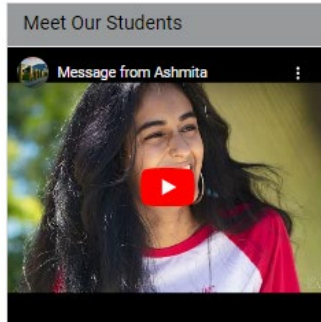





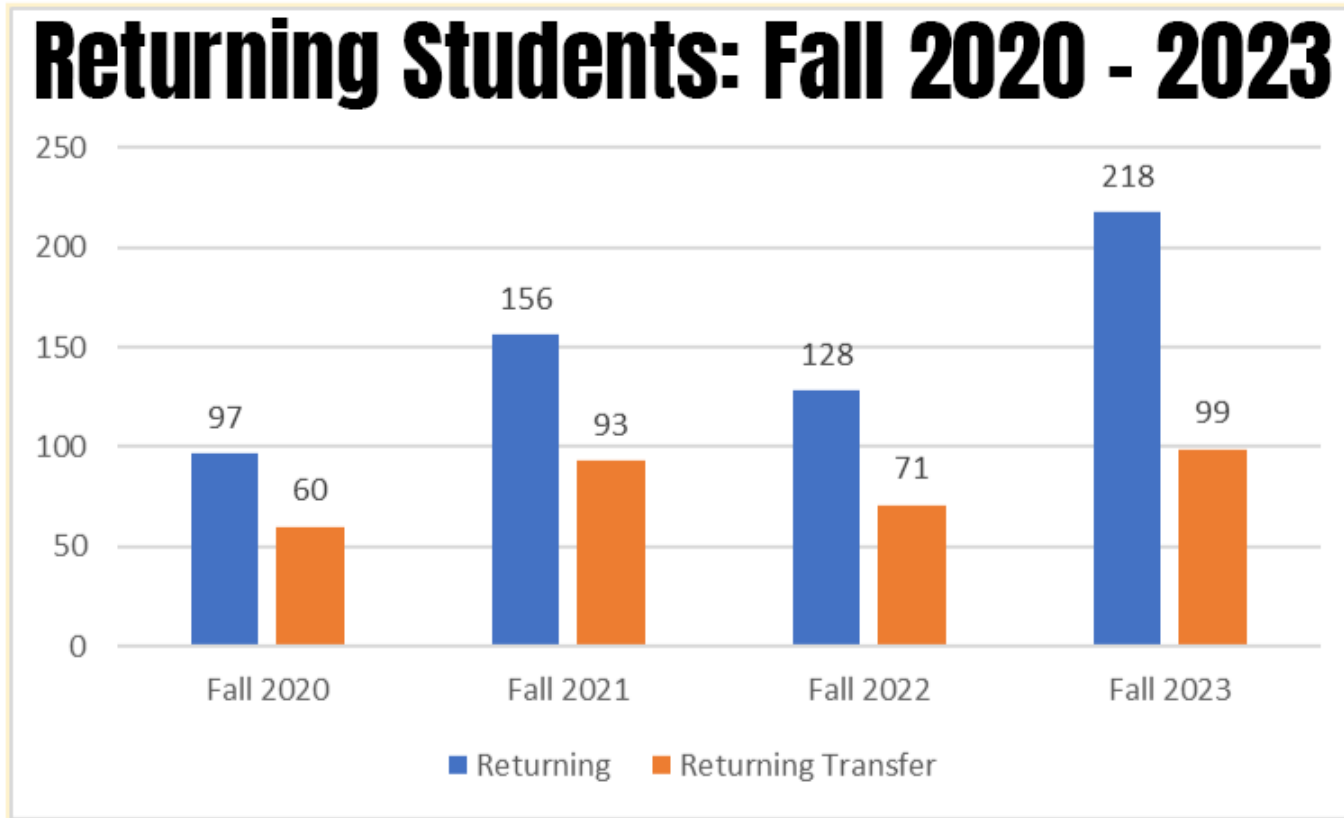


Fig. 12. Returning Students: Fall 2020-2023

With the decrease in applications, Cal State East Bay heavily recruited students who previously stopped out for various reasons to return and complete their education. The Fall 2023 application period saw a sharp increase in the rate of returning students who last attended East Bay and a modest gain with returning students who last attended another institution (Fig. 12).

Appendix 4: Staff Reduction and Increase in Efficiency and Accuracy

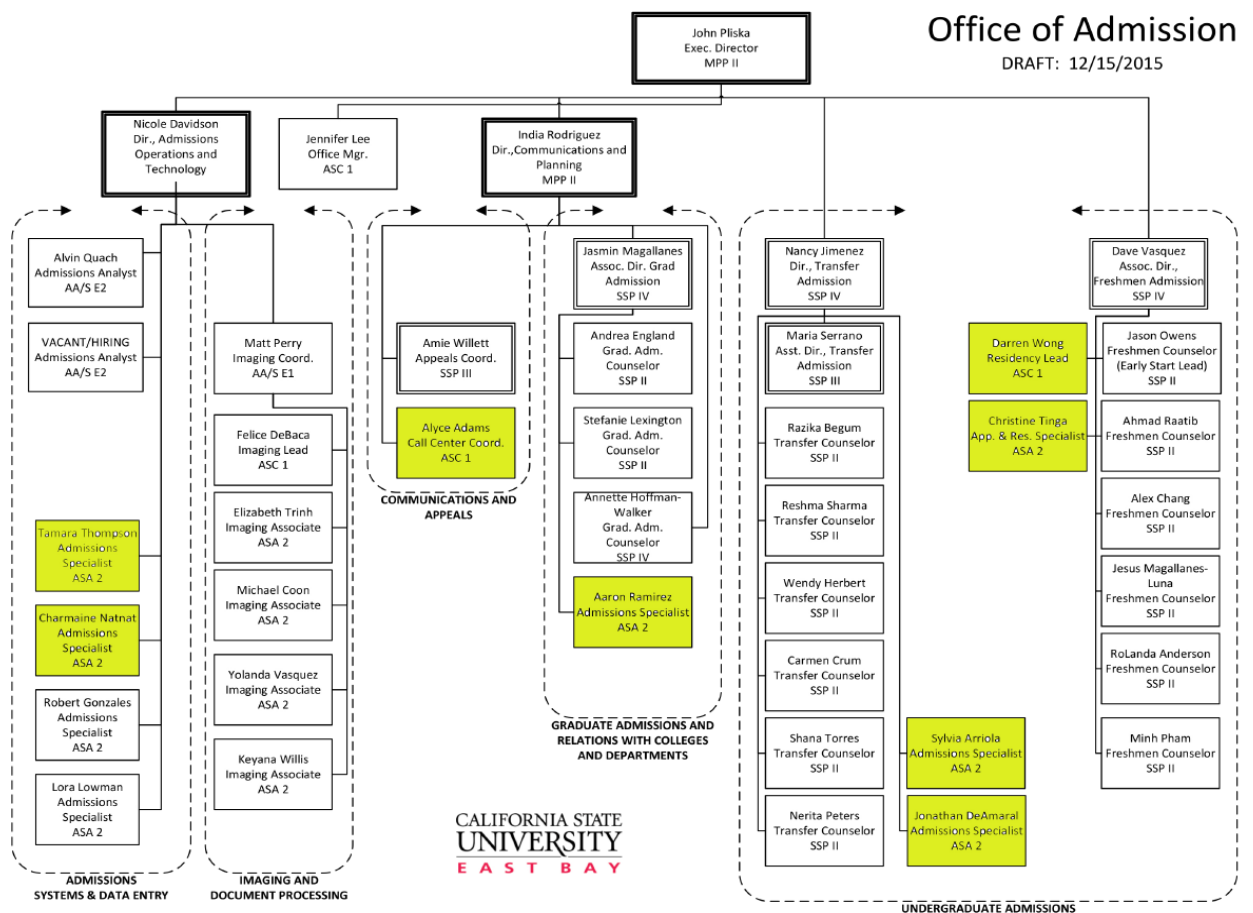


Fig. 13. Office of Admissions 2015 Staff

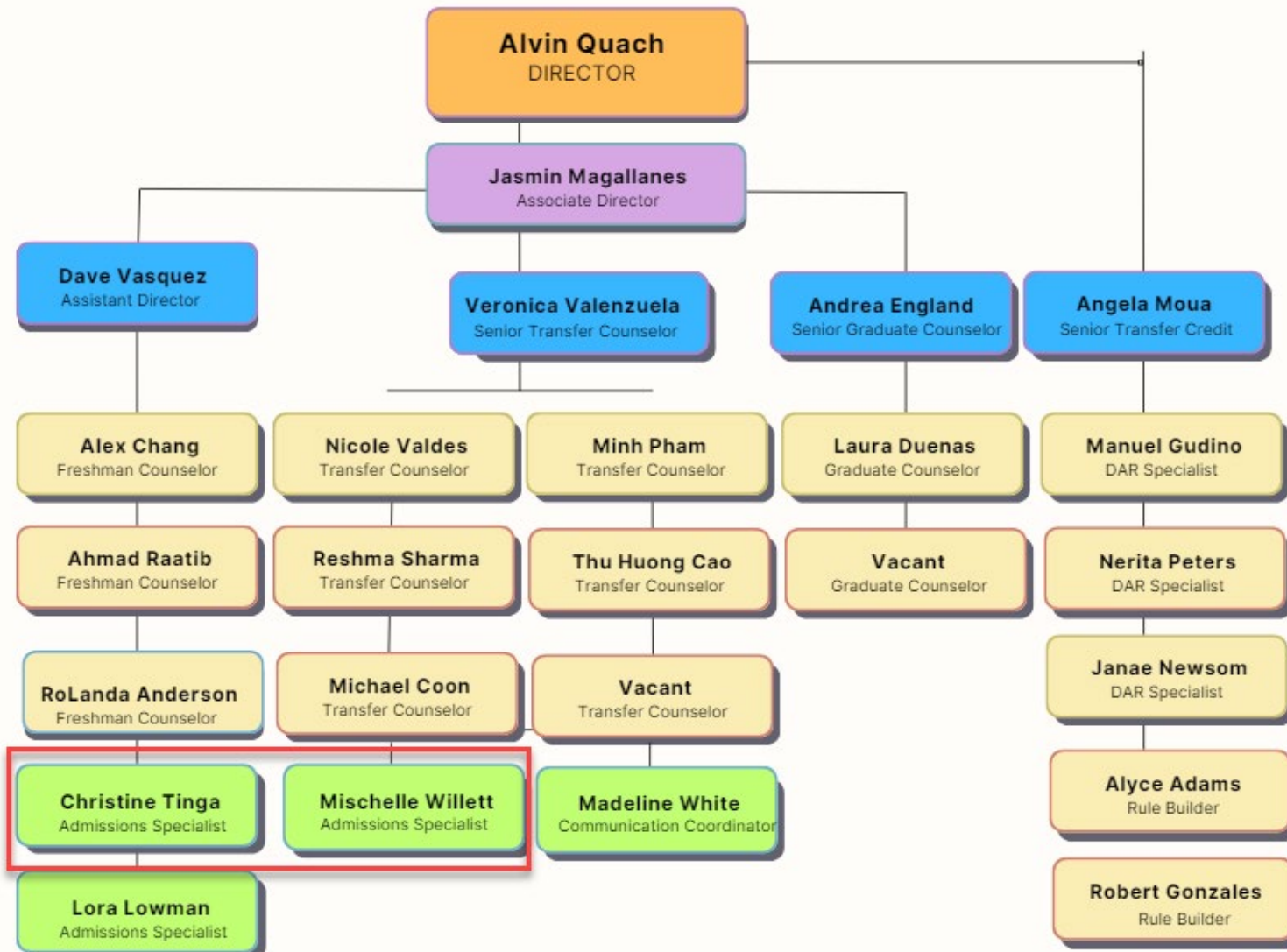


Fig. 14. Office of Admissions 2023 Staff

By improving efficiency and accuracy, the Office of Admissions reduced the number of staff as seen in the organization chart below. In Fig 13, the Office of Admissions consisted of 42 members in 2015. By 2023, that number was reduced to a total of 26 members as evidenced in Fig. 14. A noticeable reduction occurred in phone and email communication centers where the number of staff performing communication duties was reduced from 8 (in yellow) in Fig. 13 to just 2 (highlighted in red), as shown in Fig. 14.

Departmental Admission Recommendation Tool

Gone are the days of sending paper forms to and from the Admissions Office. Graduate departments now pull their own list of ready to be reviewed applicants and submit their decisions directly in Peoplesoft (Fig. 15). This method allows for real-time review and decision making, as shown in Fig. 16. This innovation relies on leveraging the power of Peoplesoft, which all staff are familiar with, making the process easily adaptable to all Cal State East Bay staff and faculty.

Transcripts that may be requested directly from eTranscriptCA are hidden from display in student portals and communications. To further convey the most accurate information to students, transcripts needed from the institutions listed above are hidden from view in the Student Portals. This technique allows for a clean and accurate presentation of the to do list, further emphasizing our commitment to only display relevant and uncluttered “To Do” items.

Transfer Credit Summary Report

Utilizing a customized Transfer Credit Summary Report (Fig. 17), staff in the Office of Admissions can quickly identify courses required to fulfill entrance requirements. The summary at the end of the report lists the required course again, along with unit and GPA information, allowing for a quick and accurate admission decision (Fig. 18).

Appendix 6: Articulation Rules and Degree Audit Report

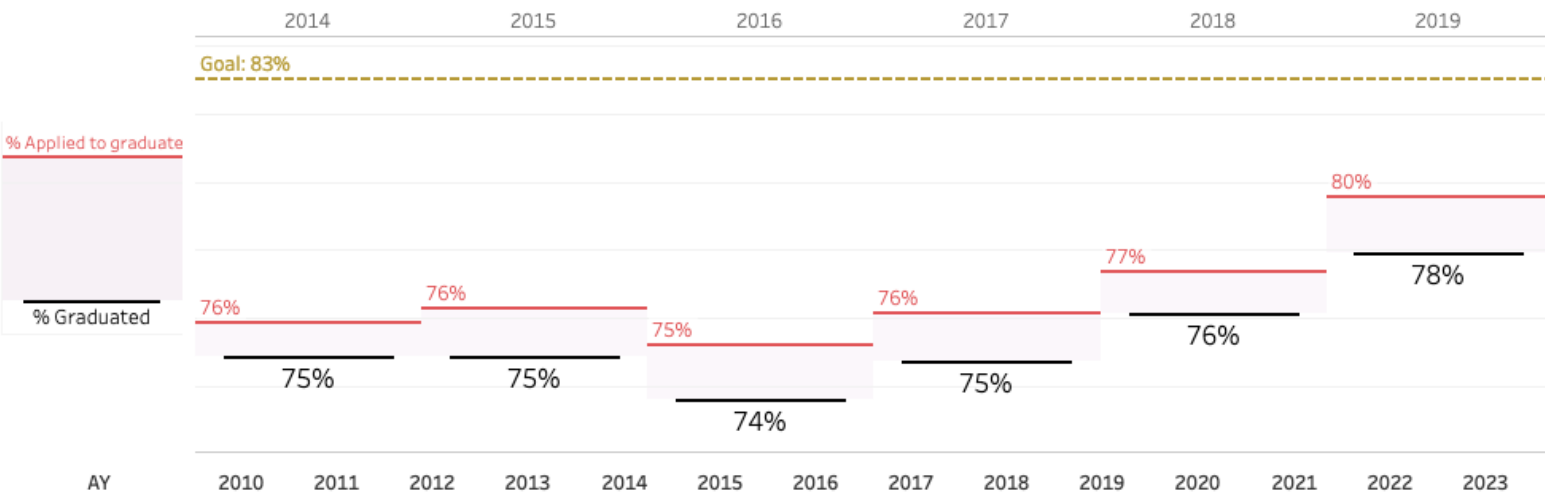
Despite a 40% reduction in its workforce, the Office of Admissions assumed the duties of building articulation rules and the evaluation of the Degree Audit Report for all incoming transfer students. In the first year of the implementation, the office reduced the wait time for the Degree Audit Report by 90 days. By comparison, some Fall 2017 admits did not receive their Degree Audit Report until March 1, 2018 whereas the latest Degree Audit Report produced for Fall 2018 admitted transfer students was completed on Nov 15, 2018. This ground-breaking accomplishment ushered in subsequent terms of higher than usual graduation rates as result of students being advised early and accurately.

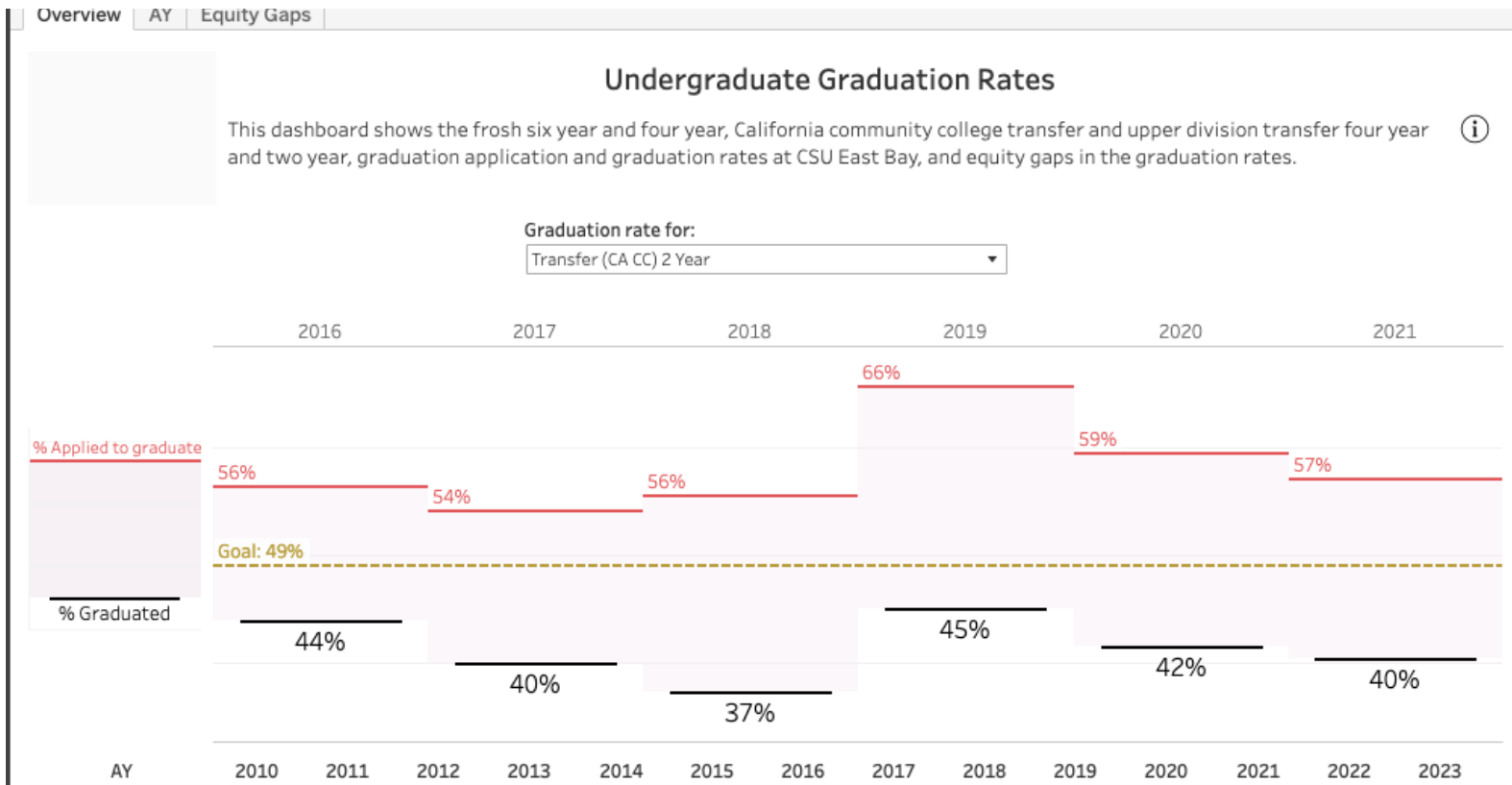
Graduation Rate Chart

To ensure the early delivery of the Degree Audit Report is not a one-time accomplishment, the office continues to build and update an average of 10,000 articulation rules each year. Queries are built to analyze unarticulated courses from higher feeder institutions. Leveraging the work that the campus already devoted to the Transfer Evaluation System (TES), courses are researched thoroughly and vetted by campus authorities, making the rules as accurate as possible.
