New (and Continuing) Extramural Awards Summary

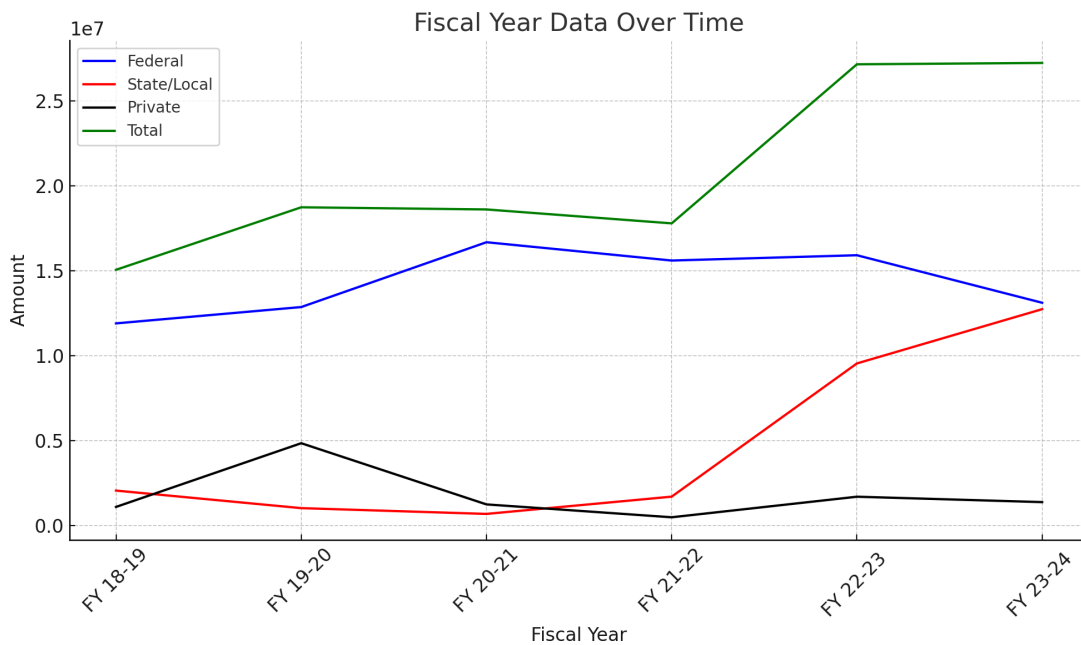

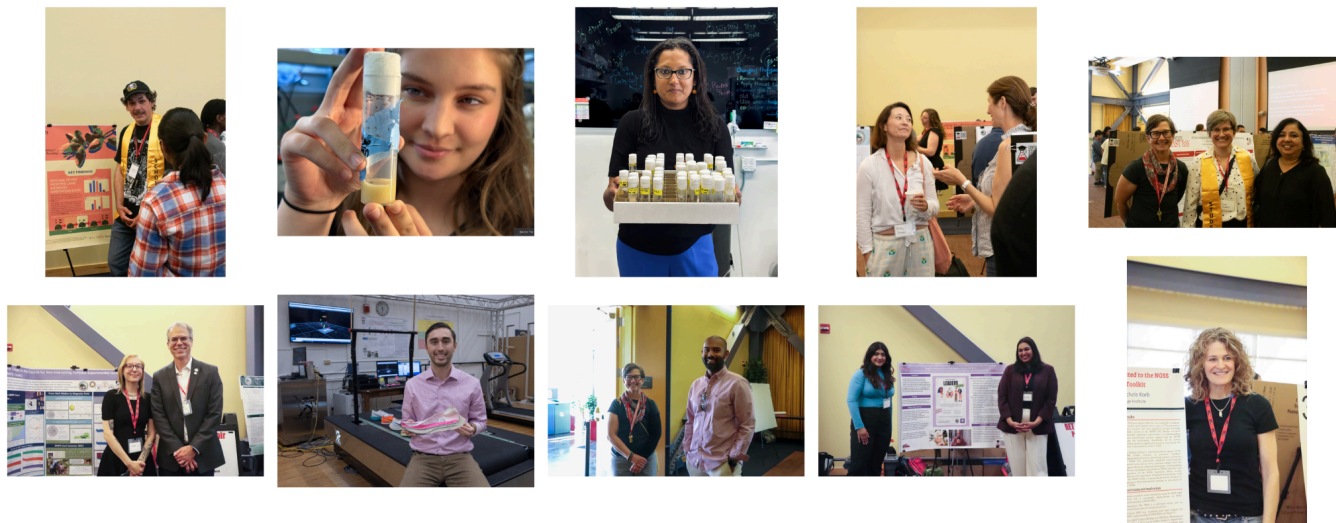
