History of the Student Investment Fund



Cal State East Bay's Student Investment Fund was established in May 2022 through the generous contributions of \$277,000 from alumni Mike Coke, Michael Dance, and Ken Pereira. Mike Coke, President and co-founder of Terreno Realty Corp., credits part of his post-graduation success to the skills

and knowledge acquired during his undergraduate experience at our university.

The Student Investment Fund serves a dual purpose. First, it enriches student education by providing hands-on experience in financial decision-making and teaches critical aspects of investment analysis and portfolio management. Second, it instills the value of philanthropy and the importance of giving back by sharing success. Each year, 5% of the fund's net assets are distributed back to students in the form of scholarships.

SIF Performance

The total value of the SIF portfolio (as of October 31, 2024) is \$552,544. Total contributions are \$408,470 and total investment earnings are \$144,074. Since inception in May of 2022, the portfolio has returned 38.10% with monthly volatility of 4.69%. For comparison, the S&P 500 has returned 38.10% with a monthly volatility of 4.79% over the same time period.

Inside the Fund: Hear from Current Students

One of my favorite lessons from the class is "never to hold onto a bad investment." I've always assumed that if a stock isn't performing well, it's fine to retain it in the portfolio since it will grow later; however, during the lecture, Professor Du mentioned, "Why hold onto something that isn't generating a return?" That was a harsh reality. Another thing that I most enjoy is how this class showed me the significance of research in the stock market and the broader world because not doing thorough research can lead to irrational investments. I also liked the class pace and discipline; it's not a regular class where we can show up whenever we want; we have to show up and do the work, just like an 8-to-5 job. I am thrilled I took the class; it has made me like finance even more.














CSUEB Students Participate in National Competition


